

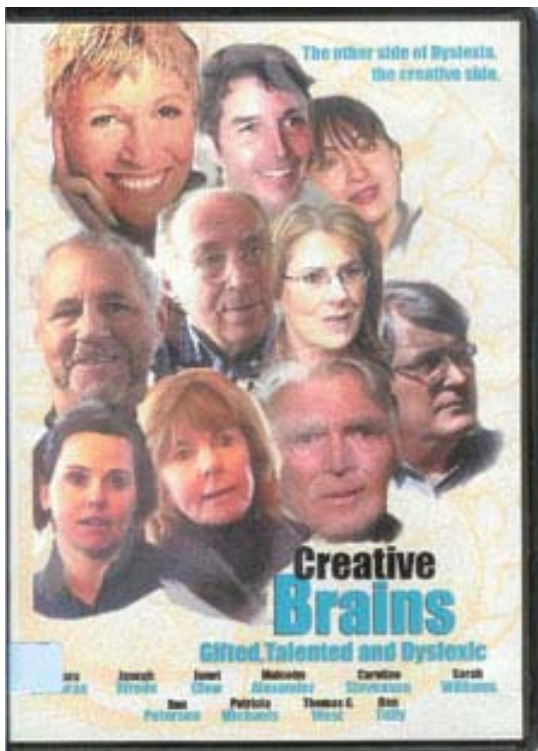
Dyslexia: Discover the Creative Brain

This session will explain the basics of dyslexia and show a documentary, displaying the personal recollections and insights of 10 accomplished people with dyslexia. They explain what seemed to be a serious impairment actually led to the development of their own special talents. Each weaves a story with memories of difficult moments - of failure that eventually evolved into a life of success, - and of the transition from focusing on weaknesses to becoming aware of strengths.

These inspiring tales of courage paint eloquent word pictures of how using one's own creativity and talents can overcome what seems to be a certain road to defeat. This presentation inspires and motivates us all, particularly those with dyslexia, and those who work with students with dyslexia.
